

The Fastest Ways to See the Fastest Cars!

The best way to see all the STPR action is by following these directions to the spectator points.

GPS, Google Maps and other navigation systems may show a shorter and faster routes, but it will they will NOT show roads that may be closed for the rally.

Don't get stuck! Follow the route instructions in this guide to the spectator points!

Important Safety Information for Spectating at STPR

IT IS CRITICAL THAT ALL SPECTATORS FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF THE MARSHALS AT ALL TIMES.

This is for the safety of the competitors, the event and most importantly, your own safety.

Never step onto a hot stage.

You must also follow marshals instructions when parking. We must keep clear access on one side of these narrow roads for emergency vehicles. All cars should park on the same side of the road and be heading in the proper direction to leave the area.

Please stay behind the yellow tape at a spectator area. Do not stretch, move or lean on the yellow tape.

The areas pictured in red in the diagrams are extremely dangerous places to be standing while a stage is hot.

At posted spectator locations marshals will have these areas marked with red tape, and will ensure no one enters them.

If you are in a location with no marshal area present, please refrain from standing in these areas.

Lead cars(Zero Cars) can and will cancel a stage if spectators are observed standing in a location they deem unsafe.

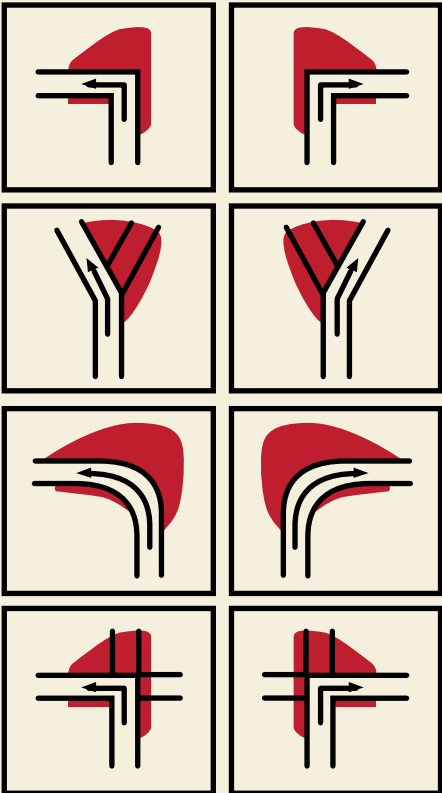
Rally cars can and will leave the road with no notice, and these areas are places where it is more likely to happen.

Be alert at all times, however, as no spot is truly a "safe" spot to stand due to the unpredictable nature of rally.

Always be ready to move if something goes wrong.

Do NOT stand in any area marked in RED in the illustration to the right. These areas are dangerous and where cars will likely have off course excursions.

 Turn left onto Spring Brook Rd.
 1 mi(21.04 mi)

 Turn right onto Union St. 449 ft
 Turn right onto West St., 0.2 mi
 Turn right onto US-6 E./W. Main St., 3.6 mi(3.8 mi)
 Turn right onto Elk Run Rd/SR 3001, 5.3 mi(9.1 mi)
 Turn right onto E. Shambaker Rd/T397 0.7 mi(9.8 mi)
 Continue straight onto Ridge Rd., 4.6 mi(14.4 mi)
 Turn your car around and park behind the last car

Saturday – Spectator Points Directions From The Green to Asaph Spectator Area

SS14 & SS18 Asaph - 11.5 mi, 20 minutes
 The Green, 118 Main St, Wellsboro
 Head North East on Main St toward US-6 W 0.2 mi
 Continue onto US-6 W/Tioga St 8.1 mi(8.3 mi)
 Turn right onto Straight Run Rd/T452 0.2 mi(8.5 mi)
 Turn left onto Marsh Creek Rd 0.5 mi(9.0 mi)
 Turn right onto Asaph Run Rd 2.7 mi(11.7 mi)
 Turn your car around and park behind the last car.

**SS11 & SS15 Ridgely
32 Miles - 55 Minutes**
 The Green 118 Main St, Wellsboro
 Continue on PA-660 W/West Ave 0.3 mi
 Continue onto PA-362 W 2.9 mi
 Turn left onto US-6 W 8.3 mi
 Turn left onto Elk Run Rd/Sr3001 towards Watrous 17 mi.
 Turn right onto Leetonia Rd at Marshlands 19.6 mi
 Turn left to stay on Leetonia Rd 27.1 mi
 Turn left onto Wilson Point Rd 29.2 mi
 Turn your car around and park behind the last car approx. 3 mi

STPR is a Leave No Trace event. If you bring it in, pack it out. STPR is also a dry event. Alcohol is not allowed in the forest. We abide by these rules and they will be enforced.

 Turn left onto Shumway Hill Rd 0.7 mi (2.8 mi.)
 Turn right onto Shumway Rd/Shumway Hill Rd.
 Continue to follow Shumway Hill Rd. 1.9 mi (4.7 mi.)
 Continue onto Antrim Rd 3.8 mi (8.5 mi.)
 Turn left onto Landfill Ln.
 Waste Management Entrance 0.5 mi (9.0 mi.)
 Turn left around WM Office/Scale
 • Ticketing in 0.5 mi
 • Follow marshal to spectator area
 • 15 mph speed limit on WM property
